

SERVICES

Routine Services that we offer include: vaccination, annual wellness checks, dental health, dietary advice, neutering/spaying, micro chipping, insurance, junior and senior pet wellness programs, worming, fleas, behavior, accessories, referral services and food/nutrition are all part of service to our clients.

Surgical Suite - We have a wide range of the latest surgical instruments and equipment allowing us to carry out even the most complex life-saving procedures on the spot. Our integral anesthetic system ensures that we can safely anaesthetize all pets from the smallest mouse to the largest dog. The surgery table is heated and body temperature is charted during the procedure. All animals under anesthesia are monitored with a pulse oximeter (to measure oxygen levels), an ECG (to measure heart function) and a respiratory monitor (to verify breathing rates and carbon dioxide). Surgeries take place only under the most sterile conditions; veterinarians and assisting technicians are dressed out in sterile scrubs with mask and gloves. Post operative recovery takes place in our ICU Hospital Ward, where the surgery technician keeps a trained eye on your pet during the recovery process.

ICU Hospital Ward - Our ICU ward is situated to allow our veterinarians and technicians to monitor our patients constantly. For pets that have suffered road accidents, undergone major surgery, those with heart problems, or smaller more exotic species that may require specialist nursing, our intensive care facilities are second to none. We even feature a fully operational Oxygen therapy cage that is ready for use at a moments notice.

Orthopedics - Small animal orthopedic surgery service is available for the diagnosis and treatment of musculoskeletal conditions, including fractured bones, joint disorders, and muscle diseases of small animals. We also offer OFA certification. Options available for fracture repair include intramedullary pins, bone plates, external skeletal fixators and interlocking nails. Surgical treatments for hip dysplasia, luxating patellas and other conditions are available.

Dentistry - 85% of all dogs and cats over one year of age have some degree of periodontal disease. A dental exam is included with every medical exam conducted. With our Dental radiograph equipment and full service dental care, we can handle everything from a routine cleaning to surgical extractions.

Isolation Ward - With its own filtered air system and washing facilities, potentially contagious diseases can be contained and managed simply and effectively. Outside excursions are also monitored in an area separate from other pets. We have both feline and canine isolation areas.

Radiology - X-rays, dental radiographs, ECGs, endoscopy and ultrasounds are immediately available. This ensures that your pet's problems are

diagnosed quickly, safely and effectively.

Laboratory - Our in house laboratory carries out many diagnostic tests including blood testing (CBC, serum chemistry, etc.) urine analysis and fecal examinations. Results can be produced the same day, ensuring that we can develop a treatment plan for your pet as quickly as possible. Early detection of disease is potentially life saving. **Consultations** - Weight control, nutrition, fleas, dental questions and basic training and behavior advice are all available.

Boarding and Overnight Care - Our facilities offer the most luxurious indoor boarding suites for cats and dogs. Barkaritaville can only be described as a home away from home and is designed with the discriminating pet owner in mind. For our feline friends, we have the "Kitty Condo Village" that cats love to explore. Our dog kennels and runs are state-of-the-art, climate controlled and monitored constantly for cleanliness.

Grooming Facilities - From all breed professional grooming to brushing their teeth, your pet will benefit from our groomer's 35 years of experience. Our full service salon ensures your pet enjoys their day in our grooming spa! For your convenience, services can also be scheduled for boarding pet during their stay.
